- 1. The moderator and all presenters will be seated on the stage.
- 2. The moderator will introduce the session and schools, will call the presenters individually if needed.
- 3. Each presenting school has a maximum of 10 minutes for their session. While slides aren't mandatory, video presentations are preferred. Oral presentations are also welcome.
- 4. Following all three presentations, a Question and Answer segment (30 minutes) will take place.
- 5. Refer to the guide questions. The moderator will decide which questions to pose and will assign speakers/responders. The moderator can also formulate questions. The moderator can also solicit questions from the audience.
- 6. The session will be concluded with the moderator summarizing the discussion, highlighting 1-3 key takeaways.
